The Park Avenue United Methodist Church is seeking a Youth Minister to develop and lead a dynamic and comprehensive ministry for our youth from grade 6 through 12, and their families, with a primary goal of faith formation.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and implement ministries for youth that will help them grow in practicing their faith including Sunday morning worship, midweek formation, fellowship and local service opportunities
- Engage youth in meaningful relationships that work to build a vibrant Youth Ministry
- Design and implement a plan that will increase youth involvement and student leadership at Park Avenue United Methodist Church (PAUMC)
- Facilitate outreach and connection with neighborhood youth and families through regular volunteering or involvement in the community surrounding PAUMC
- Design and Implement invitational events providing the opportunity for youth to bring friends
- Establish a relationship with each PAUMC youth
- Develop and implement milestone programming for youth from grade 6 through 12 including welcoming new sixth graders and their families to the youth program, coordinating arrangements for Confirmation, facilitating recognition of high school graduates, and providing support as youth transition out of high school and into college/work life
- Coordinate and lead mission trips
- Recruit and provide on-going supervision of adult youth ministry volunteers
- Communicate effectively with parents of youth
- Participate in PAUMC Youth Council meetings (monthly) and coordinate with PAUMC Children's Ministry
- Provide updates on youth ministry developments and needs to Associate Pastor
- Ensure all PAUMC youth ministry volunteers have a current background check and are trained in Safe Gatherings practices
- Manage the budget for youth ministry
- Other duties as assigned
